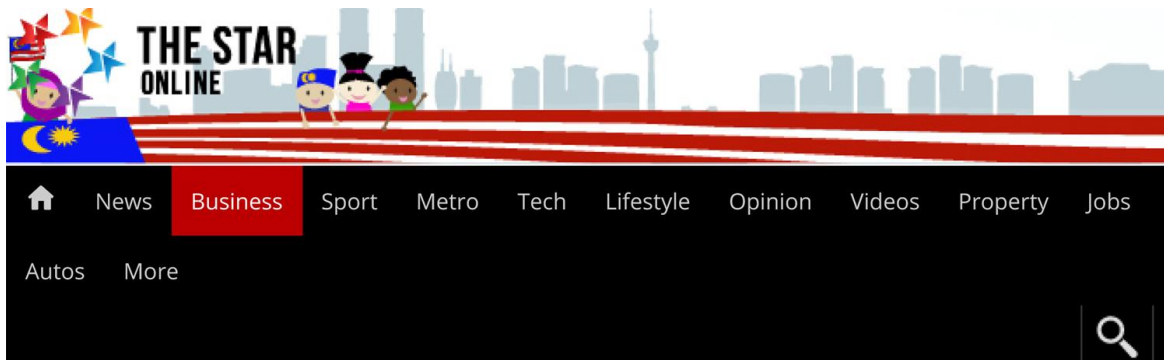

# George Kent bags RM31.2m deal to supply water meters to HK

KUALA LUMPUR: George Kent (Malaysia) Bhd has secured a US\$7.17mil (RM31.19mil) contract to supply water meters to the Water Supplies Department of Hong Kong.

It said on Tuesday the contract involved the supply and delivery of 600,000 water meters following a highly competitive bidding process.

George Kent said the water meters to be supplied to over the next two years are the DN15 Brass PSM-Ts.

“By industry standards, this single order of 600,000 water meters by any water authority is an extremely big order. The largest single order for water meters ever obtained in the history of George Kent,” it said.

George Kent group chairman, Tan Sri Tan Kay Hock said, “The tender award further establishes our position and reputation as the market leader of world class and superior quality metering products.

“It also serves as an acknowledgement that we are equipped with superior technical expertise and world class supply chain that enables us to be competitive at an international level.”

George Kent’s water meter manufacturing facility based in Puchong, Selangor is the biggest in the Asean region with a total production capacity of two million water meters per year.

The metering revenue for its own export markets amounted to 40% of total manufacturing output for the FYE2015.
