Mitrajaya, George Kent bag construction awards

MITRAJAYA Holdings Bhd's wholly owned subsidiary, Pembinaan Mitrajaya Sdn Bhd, was awarded a contract worth RM74.31 million by MRCB Builders Sdn Bhd to undertake superstructure works for Tower 3 of a mixed office block development at PJ Sentral.

The construction company noted in a filing yesterday that the contract will commence on Dec 9, 2016, for a duration of 14 months and is expected to be completed by Feb 9, 2018.

Separately, construction engineering and water meter maker George Kent (M) Bhd received a contract worth RM277.19 million from the Works Department to build a 150-bed hospital in Tanjung Karang, Selangor.

The hospital is to be constructed on a 17-acre (6.9ha) site facing the main trunk road between Tanjung Karang and Kuala Selangor. The contract will commence on Nov 24, 2016, and is to be completed over a period of 48 months.
